# ALABAMA FIRST RESPONDERS BENEFITS PROGRAM



**COVERAGE AND BENEFITS SUMMARY** 

#### FIREFIGHTER ELIGIBILITY:

Firefighters in the state of Alabama who have actively served as a Career Firefighter, Certified Volunteer Firefighter, or Non-Certified Volunteer Firefighter for at least 12 consecutive months are eligible for coverage under Alabama First Responders Benefits Program.

- CAREER PAID FIREFIGHTER: Any firefighter employed with the state, a county or municipal government, an airport authority, or a fire district who has obtained certification as a firefighter through and as defined by the Alabama Firefighters' Personnel Standards and Education Commission, or a firefighter employed by the Alabama Forestry Commission whohas been certified by the State Forester as having met the wild land firefighter training standard of the National Wildfire Coordinating Group, and is offered typical employment benefits, including health insurance coverage.
- CERTIFIED VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER: Any firefighter who is an active member of a volunteer or
  combination career and volunteer fire department, as recognized by the Alabama Forestry Commission,
  and who has obtained certification as a volunteer firefighter through and as defined by the Alabama
  Firefighters' Personnel Standards and Education Commission, who may or may not receive remuneration
  for firefighting activities, but is not offered typical employment benefits, including health insurance
  coverage.
- NON-CERTIFIED VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER: Any firefighter who is an active member of a volunteer or combination career and volunteer fire department, as recognized by the Alabama Forestry Commission, and who has not obtained certification as a volunteer firefighter through and as defined by the Alabama Firefighters' Personnel Standards and Education Commission, who may or may not receive remuneration for firefighting activities, but is not eligible for typical employment benefits, including health insurance coverage.

#### **COVERAGE OPTIONS:**

Legislation *requires* that Departments provide both Lump Sum Cancer and Long-Term Disability Coverages to all *Career Paid Firefighters*. Departments have the *option* to provide Lump Sum Cancer and Long-Term Disability Coverages for *Certified Volunteer and Non-Certified Volunteer Firefighters*.

There are two options for Lump Sum Cancer Coverage – the **Basic Plan** and the **Enhanced Plan**. The Basic Plan provides benefits for legislated cancers. Legislated cancers include "bladder, blood, brain, breast, cervical, esophageal, intestinal, kidney, lymphatic, lung, prostate, rectum, respiratory tract, skin, testicular, and thyroid cancer, leukemia, multiple myeloma, Hodgkin's lymphoma, and non-Hodgkin's lymphoma." The Enhanced Plan provides benefits for all cancers.

All of the rates above assume that the Employer/Department will be paying for 100% of the cost of all Firefighters (Career Paid, Certified Volunteer and Non-Certified Volunteers) in the Department.

Should a Department decline to purchase coverage for Certified Volunteer and Non-Certified Volunteer Firefighters, the individual firefighters have the option to purchase coverage on their own at a higher rate. Please refer to the pricing below for the estimated annual cost that would be passed along to the individual firefighter. Payments for individual coverage must be made to the firefighter's Department and remitted to us.
